-  Telephone



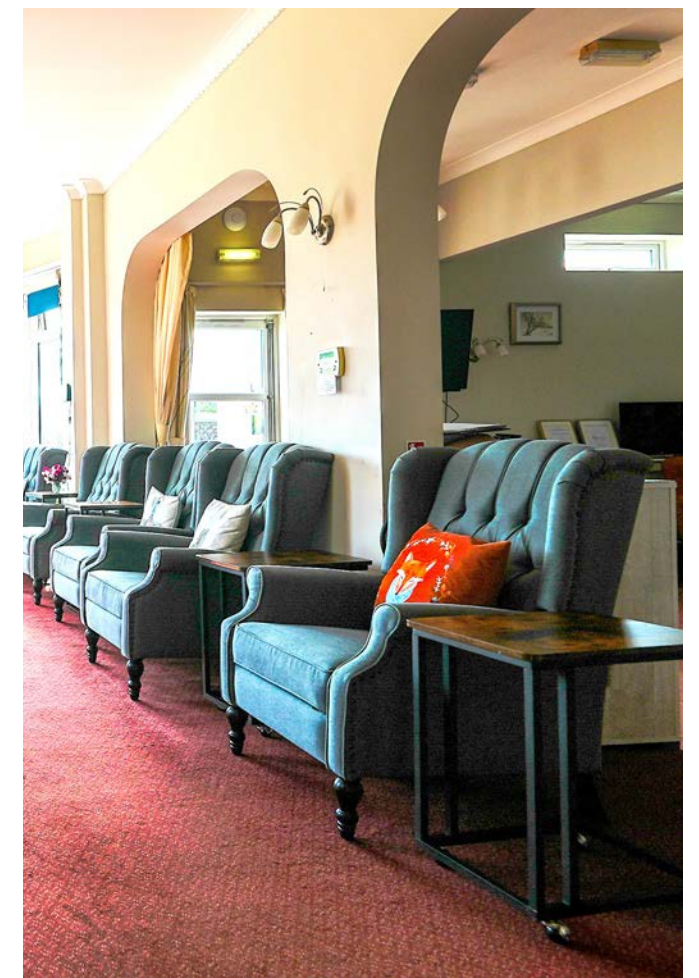

Communal Areas

All of the communal areas of Brampton Lodge are bright and spacious, spotlessly clean and attractively decorated. A permanent maintenance person is employed to keep the home in perfect order. The home is suitably designed for easy wheelchair use. All doors are extra wide, a lift provides access to the bedrooms on the first floor and a ramp from the lounge door at the back enables our less mobile residents to benefit from the lovely garden outside.

A large patio with generous seating is particularly well used and appreciated in the warm weather by both residents and visitors.

Her aim is to ensure Brampton Lodge maintains as well as improves its high standards it is known for, and to ensure that the people living at Brampton are enabled to live fulfilling lives with positive outcomes and experiences.



Meet our Team

Our outstanding care team are also dedicated and highly qualified; most have completed NVQ levels 2 or 3. We insist on a high standard of care, so our employees are carefully selected, full induction training is provided and continuing professional development is undertaken by each member of staff periodically. Attentive and compassionate carers are available twenty four hours a day. The high staff- resident ratio enables us to provide companionship and stimulation, as well as tending to all your physical needs.

In addition to the Care staff, Brampton Lodge also employs an expert cook, domestic staff, kitchen assistants and a maintenance person.

Health

The prime objective of our home is to promote and foster health and well-being. Upon your admission, a pre-assessment of needs will be performed by a senior member of the care team, from which a Care Plan will be created. You, your relatives and doctors will be offered and encouraged to participate in the drafting of your Care Plan. A review will be conducted monthly, unless changes in your condition necessitate more frequent reviews.

When you join the home, we recommend that you remain with your own doctor, who is familiar with your health and history. If you are from outside the area, you are welcome to join our local doctors' practice.

In case of illness, your relatives will be informed immediately and will be updated regularly on your recovery. If your family members wish to be present whilst you are ill, we can arrange suitable accommodation for them. If you will be using the home for convalescent purposes, you will be attended by one of our senior team members to prepare you for discharge home.
